Dave Huether is the Deputy Director of Research at the National Travel and Tourism Office (NTTO), which part of the International Trade Administration at the U.S. Department of Commerce, where he oversees the production of the Federal government's official travel and tourism statistics.

Prior to joining NTTO in 2020, Dave served as Senior Vice President for Research at the U.S. Travel Association, where he led the organization's efforts related to economic impact, market research and advocacy efforts in support of the travel and tourism industry.

Dave joined U.S. Travel Association after serving for a decade as the chief economist at the National Association of Manufacturers. In that role, he was the NAM's economic forecaster as well as principal spokesman on economic matters important to America's industrial base.

Dave previously worked at the Bureau of Economic Analysis at the U.S. Department of Commerce. He received his bachelor's degree from Guilford College and his master's degree in economics from the George Washington University.
