### Ride the Oregon City Elevator

Take a ride to the top of the only outdoor municipal elevator in the United States for a scenic view of Oregon City. Originally built about 1915, the present elevator and landmark icon replaced the former wooden structure and was dedicated on May 5, 1955. It is one of only four municipal elevators in the world. Open Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m.-7 p.m. and Sunday 10 a.m.-7 p.m. The upper level and wraparound viewing deck is complemented by display of lenticular prints, created by artist Michael Asbill.

### Guided Hike at Silver Falls State Park



People call it the “crown jewel” of the Oregon State Parks system, and once you visit, you know why. Silver Falls State Park is the kind of standout scenic treasure that puts Oregon firmly onto the national—and international—stage.
